IRRIGATION SEASON

The Town will start turning on the non-potable irrigation systems on 4/17! The communities of Maplewood, Aspen Meadows, Governor's Ranch, and Governor's Crossing can begin using their systems towards the end of the day. Testing and repairing your system are excluded, but remember the following

water restrictions: No watering between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6 p.m., and residences with even-numbered addresses shall water on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays of each week, while residences with odd-numbered addresses shall water on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays of each week.
