1000 BOOKS BEFORE KINDERGARTEN

The Eaton Public Library was awarded a \$15,000 grant from the Weld Trust Foundation to implement the 1000 Books Before Kindergarten Program! How it works: read a book, any book to your child, with the goal of reading 1,000 books before they enter kindergarten. Parents can track the number of books read on a special reading log and

come to the library to pick up free books and finger puppets for each milestone. The program promotes reading to newborns, infants, and toddlers, encourages parent and child bonding, builds home libraries, and prepares kids to be successful when they start school! 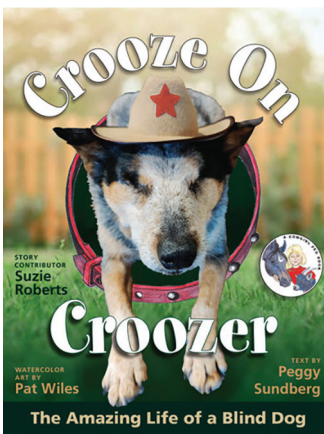
The Board is the town's legislative body, having responsibility for enacting town ordinances, appropriating funds to conduct town business, and providing policy direction to town staff.
