WATER SCHEDULING IN PLACE

As the temperature gets warmer and the rain (finally) slows down, we wanted to remind residents of watering restrictions in place for all residential customers.

To conserve water, the Town of Eaton has the following watering restrictions in place:

- No watering between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- Residences with even-numbered addresses shall water on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays of each week and residences with odd-numbered addresses shall water on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays of each week.



With all this rain, we'd also like to remind residents to follow Town Code when it comes to landscaping requirements which states that all landscaping shall be reasonably maintained.

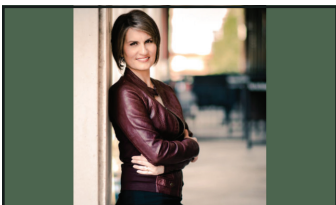
