ROADWAY PLANNING UPDATE

The Town Board of Trustees is considering asking our community to invest in roadway improvements through a 1% sales and use tax dedicated to the repair and maintenance of roads and streets in Eaton. The Board will decide if the question will be added to the November election at their August 17 Regular

Meeting. Currently, about 59% of the Town of Eaton's roadways are in fair, marginal, or poor condition. Every \$1 invested now in preventative maintenance, saves \$4 to \$10 in rehabilitation and reconstruction costs later. The Town Board heard a presentation on the proposed initiative at the July 20 Board meeting which



included information on public engagement, survey results, and possible next steps. Learn more about the possible sales and use tax, why it's needed, and more at townofeaton.colorado.gov/roads.
